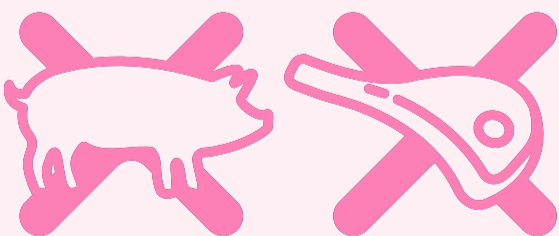

## Do not be the carrier of a deadly pig disease



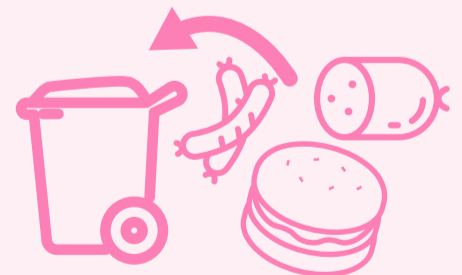
## YOU MUST TAKE PRECAUTIONS
